    - This alterations and renovation project included all site work; all interior and exterior design work prepared by the architect. The interior of the Transfiguration Temple included Orthodox painted murals on the walls and ceilings (which required that all work had to be protected from any damage). The roofs contained the Orthodox theme of gold colored "onion" shaped domes, crosses etc.
  - 2. Renovations and Alterations to Residential Area; currently in the Design Development Phase. Mr. Bishop has worked with architect and Owner since day one to make sure the project is to the Owner's budget and schedule. Work expected to start Spring 2022. Work will include site work; living areas; conference rooms, guests suites, as well as repairing the envelope of the building.

- B) Rehabilitation of St. Peter's Residence, Troy, New York, a four story Supportive Occupancy Apartments, sponsored by DePaul Housing and Property Services, of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Albany. This project was also interfaced with two state agencies: The New York State Office of Temporary and Disabilities Assistance (HHAP) and the Dormitory Authority. This project was a complete renovation of the building, which included phasing and relocation of occupants within the building while under construction. Project duration was approximately 16 months and project budget approximately \$4,300,000.00. (Additional reference: Mr. Thomas Coates (518) 376-8295.)
- Parish, Lake George, New York. This project was for the complete renovation of the parish's "summer church", a building of approximately 7,500 SF. Bishop Beaudry acted as the Construction Manager working with Architect and Building Committee. This building completely transformed the space into being the new permanent worship space for the parish included all architectural to meet the requirements of the Diocese, complete new exterior stone facing; and complete M/E. Project duration was approximately 12 months of planning and interfacing with the Diocese and approximately 14 months of construction (time included waiting for phasing approvals, etc...). This project was 1 of 2 projects featured in the magazine "Construction Leaders Today, Fall 2011 Issue." Approximate cost \$1,400,00.00. Mr. John Bishop interfaced with all parties to "value engineer" the project and work with the architect and building committee.
